



## How to write Introduction

**Note:** These are not vague tips. These are lessons and tricks we(WriteToBelAS.com) team has learned from its own experience over years and multiple attempts.. We cracked mains repeatedly with very high scores in new pattern. We hope these will also help you.

These answer writing tips are in addition to earlier list on answer writing tips.

In this section we will be enlisting tips for writing introduction.

### Tips for Introduction

- Read each question very carefully and understand the question completely. Try to **underline** its parts and subparts.
- Before start of writing any answer may be in exam hall or at home, devote 1 minute per question for making structure of answer.

( Structure may include, brief bullets, examples, diagram hint etc. which ever you can recall). This serves two purposes

1. You can recall better, more points = more dimensions = more marks.
  2. Answer would be more structured
  3. This will ensure that you will write fast answer. Other was we even don't realize when our pen stops and we start thinking about answer points.
- Structure of answer must address all subparts and time availability.

**Note:-** If your are writing ins exam hall or test where 20 questions are there use HB pencil(keep 3-4 sharpened pencils handy in each paper) to make structure of all 20 questions in one go. That too within 18-20 minutes. Initially you may feel delay you are lagging behind 20 minutes. But In exam hall soon after one

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and a half hour you will be back on track. On the other hand quality of answers would be maintained. In end you can save time also. Because you will writing as per structure.

- In a 10 marks question 1.5 line while in a 15 marks question 2.5 lines are more than enough. In this new pattern i.e. 2013 onwards. Introduction is required but not the literature survey paragraph.
- As there are dedicated marks 1 or ½ marks reserved for introduction.
- You can introduce some facts figure, number, percentage in your introduction line. You can quote some reports also. Ex WB, UNDP, IMF etc
- Don't waste time and directly come to the demand of question. There are no additional marks for extra theory you write. Demand of question should be addressed first.
- Alternatively you can draw a box 
- You can write your bullet facts in brief in this box. This is also equivalent to Introduction. It's innovative way and fetched higher marks.
